To the Village of Whitney Point water Department:

GENTLEMEN:

I, the undersigned, owner of the property situated at:

Broome County, New York, request you to supply me with water, for which I agree to pay you the established rates, and use the water in conformity with your established rules. I, understand the following to be the conditions of water supply:

1. That I will honestly comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Village of Whitney Point Water Department.
2. That the Superintendent or proper Agents of said Water Department shall have access at all reasonable times to all parts of the premises to which water Is supplied.
3. That the said Water Department shall have the right at any time, without notice to **shut off the** water in their mains, or any of them, in case of conflagration, for making repairs or extensions, or for other purposes and all consumers having boilers within their premises, not supplied by tanks or cisterns, but depending upon the pressure in the pipes to keep them supplied, are hereby cautioned against danger of collapse. Risk of damage in all cases must be exclusively on the consumer. In case of danger the hot water faucet should be opened.
4. That the said Water Department undertakes only to use all reasonable care and diligence to provide a constant supply of water through its pipes to consumers, and that it is manifestly to every interest of said Water Department that no break, failure or accident occur; but that in the event of such occurrence the said Water Department shall not be liable to any consumer for any damages resulting from the public enemy, the elements, or any accident, misfortune, failure or break in the machinery, reservoir or pipes of said Water Department.
5. That the Water Department shall have the power at any time to ascertain by meter the quantity used, and charge meter rates. The meter will be loaned and kept in repair by the Water Department, except In case of freezing, hot water damage to disc, or misuse, when the consumer will be held responsible. In case of the meter ceasing to register the quantity of water consumed, the account will be made by an average of another meter, or by the amount charged during a previous corresponding period, at the discretion of said Water Department. The accuracy of a meter can be tested at any time by drawing one cubic foot of water, which will contain seven and one-half gallons or sixty-two and one-half pounds.
6. That I will at once notify the Water Department of any change In ownership of this property and of any change In the plumbing.
